- **Arguments opposing transfers**
 - Internet resources are public goods
 - Unused resources should be returned to the RIPE NCC and redistributed
 - Counter-argument: It's very difficult to identify “unused”

IPv4 Allocations**





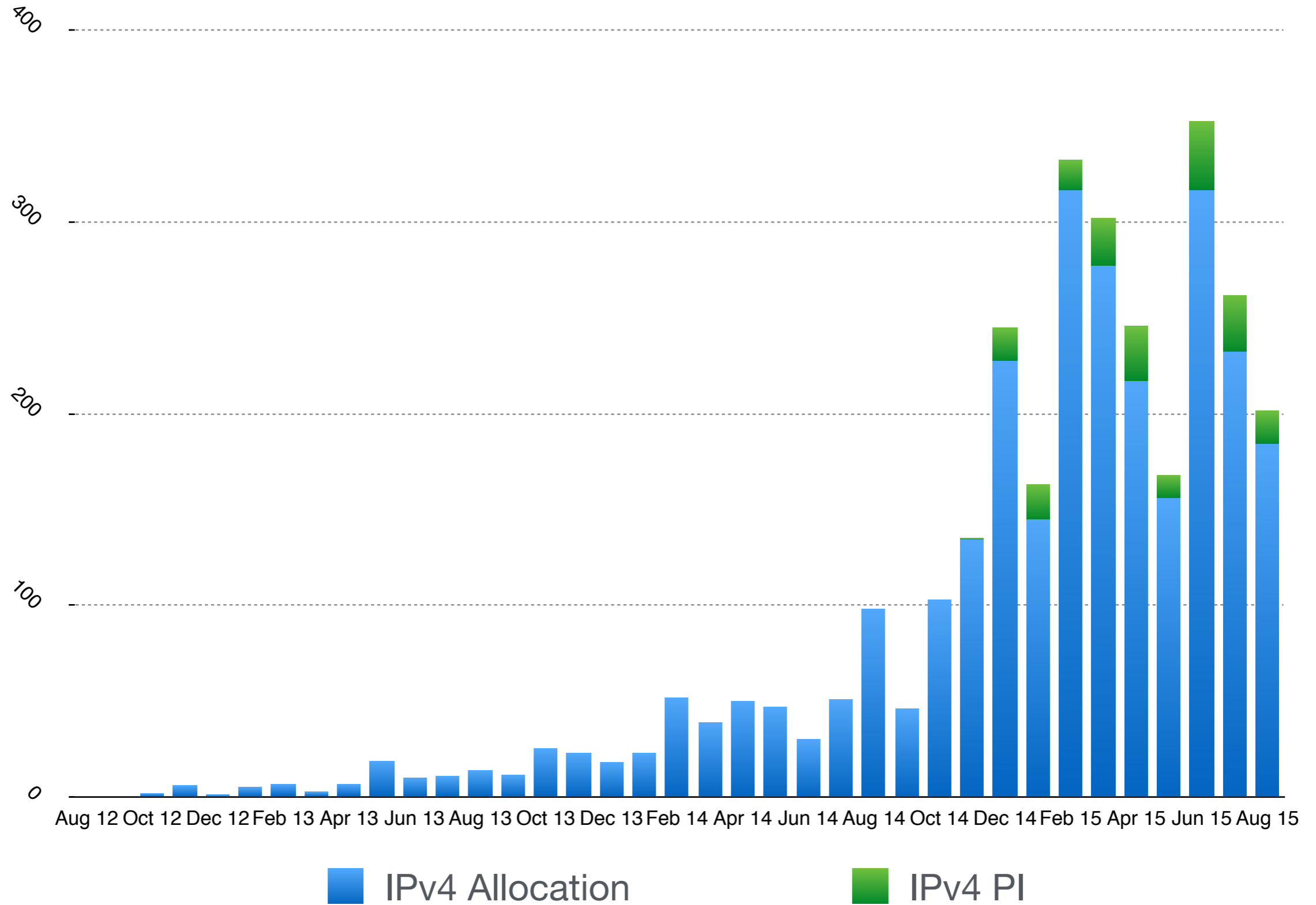




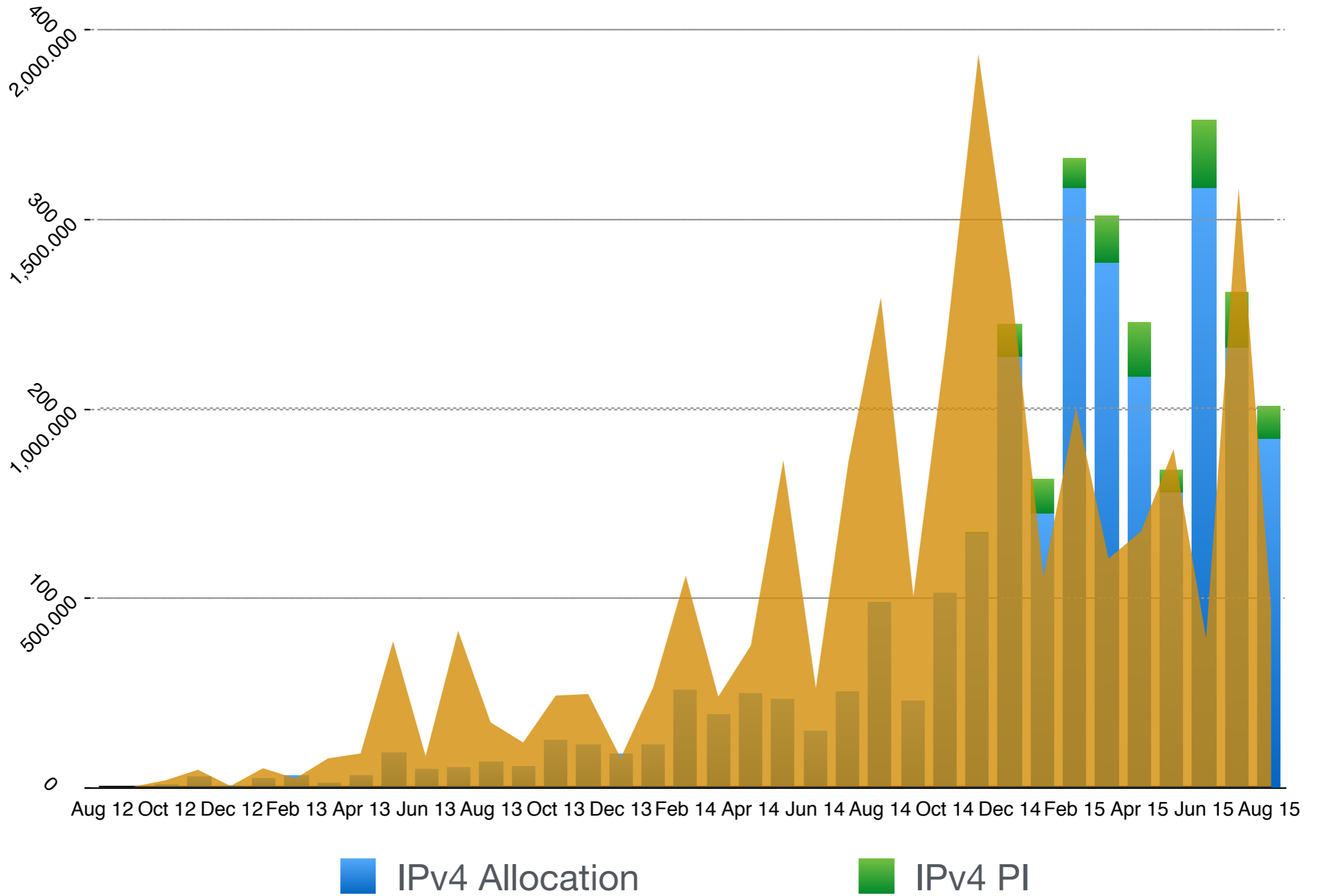








RIPE NCC IPv4 Transfers

- IPv4 transfers (intra-RIR and inter-RIR), need assessment for intra- and incoming transfers
- ASN transfers (intra-RIR and inter-RIR)

- **RIPE NCC**

- IPv4, IPv6 & ASN transfers (intra-RIR and inter-RIR), need confirmation

- **AFRINIC & LACNIC**

- None
