

2015-2: Inter-RIR Transfer Policy Proposal

Why is this proposal good?

- If a network needs more IPv4 addresses, the only place to get them is from the IPv4 Market.
- It is good to register new IPv4 addresses in your “home” RIR (LACNIC) so you get local support, and you pay only one RIR’s fees.

Proposal is **one-way**:

Allow networks which:

- operate in the LACNIC region
- have excess IPv4 addresses in other RIRs
- move that space from another RIR **to** LACNIC

The original 2015-2 text has been modified to:

- Remove two-way language
- Allow for 12 month use (not 24 months)
